



Safety, Health and Environment according to 018 SCC standards (training for operative employees)

Certification system SCC (Safety Certificate for Contractors) is designed particularly for the contractor companies and their employees and is used as a management system in the field of Health, Labor Safety and Environment protection (SGU). The European standard SCC is widely acknowledged and its use is spreading constantly among the contractor companies in such areas as construction, mechanical engineering, metalworking, energetics, as well as oil and chemical industry.



The aim of the course

To provide basic knowledge about the practical issues concerning SHE and to prepare trainees for an SCC exam.

- ▶ Electricity and radiation
- ▶ Exam
